## RCIA

Although the process of initiating adults into the Catholic faith will not begin until early September, it is time for us to begin forming a team. If you have ever thought about being apart of this wonderful ministry, please pray about it as you consider joining us this year. Help is needed in the following areas:

**RCIA SPONSORS:** Sponsors play a crucial part of the initiation of adults into the Catholic Faith. Journeying with a candidate or catechumen is a faith-filled and rewarding experience. No expertise is necessary, just fellowship and support while traveling with the candidate as he/continues to walk in God's presence.

**HOSPITALITY TEAM:** Hospitality is at the heart of the RCIA process. Welcoming those who are seeking to learn about the Catholic faith, is a response to God's call to share His presence in the community. Like the Sponsors, those who serve in this ministry give witness to the candidates that the people the of St. Thomas community welcome and support them on their journey of faith. Responsibilities include setting, serving and cleaning up refreshments and mingling with the candidates before each session and during the refreshment time. Ideally, if there are 8 volunteers on the team, each individual would need be available only once a month.

## RCIC

The Children's Catechumenate (RCIC) is the formation process of older children Grades 3 and up

- Who have not been baptized
- Who have been baptized but have had no formation
- Who have been baptized in another denomination and are seeking full communion with the Catholic Church

Registration for this process will take place with the regular Religious Education Program. If you have questions regarding this process of formation, please call Eileen in the Religious Education Office, 358-2461, ext. 16.
